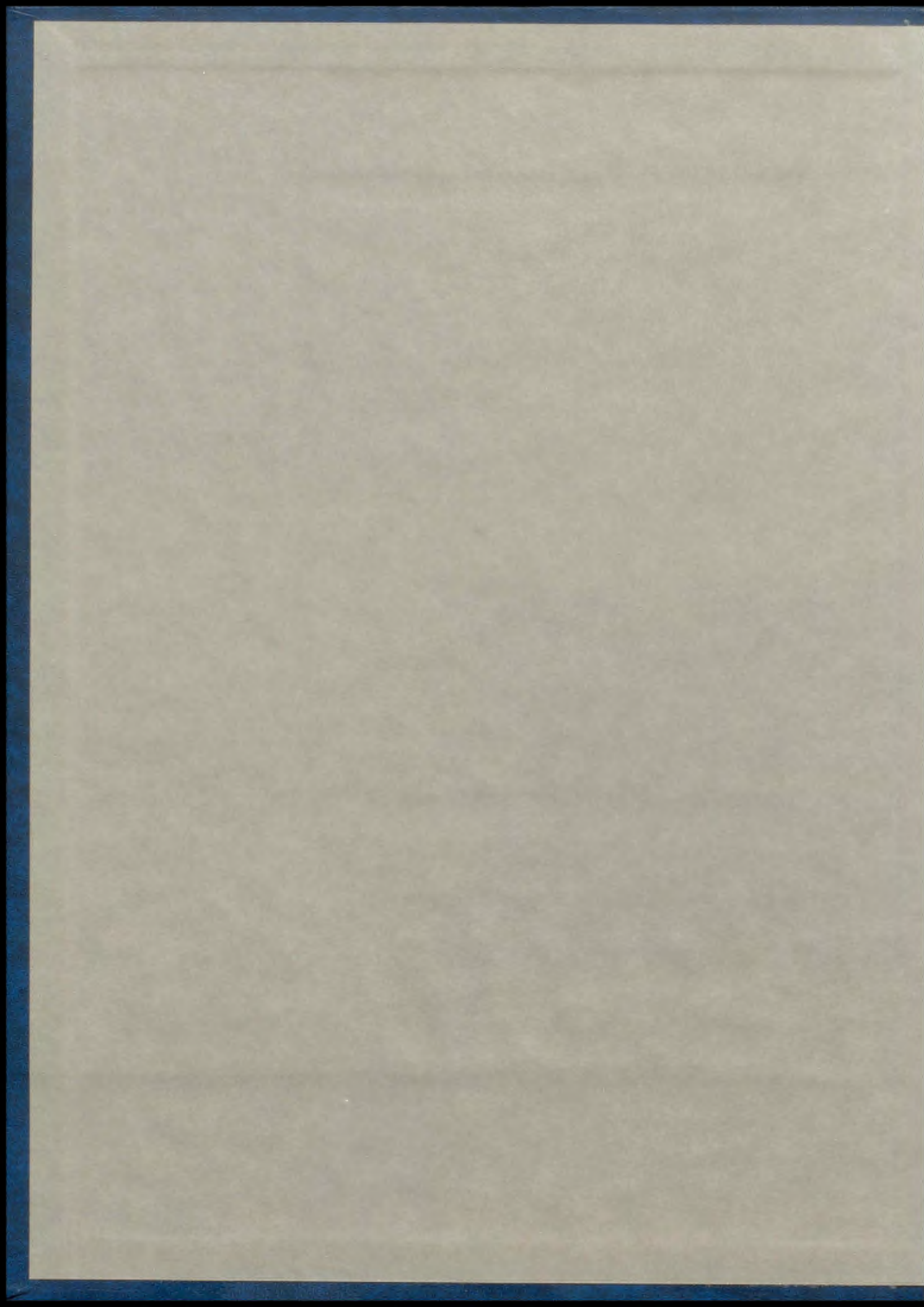



# DEDICATION

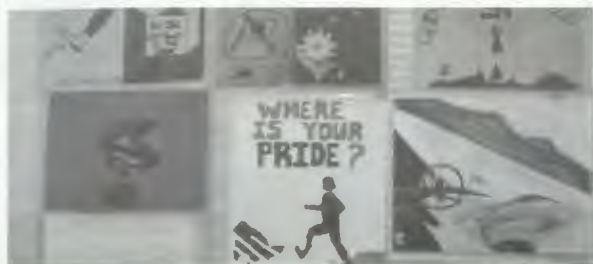
